Generation 2000 is operated solely by young people with guidance from a diverse board of advisors. Financed by its own fundraising efforts, the organization receives donations in kind, logistical support and funding from a variety of benefactors in both the public and private sectors.

In 1991-92, Generation 2000 will initiate the following youth programs: a Canada-wide School Tour, a Cross-Country Bicycle Tour and a Summer Job Exchange.

THE GENERATION 2000 NATIONAL SCHOOL TOUR Generation 2000 is sponsoring a tour of Canadian high schools, colleges and universities in an effort to emphasize the positive aspects of Canada's regional diversity. The National School Tour consists of three phases: a video presentation, school assemblies, and a national opinion survey.

THE CROSS-CANADA BICYCLE TOUR During the summer of 1992, Generation 2000 is sponsoring the bike tour in an effort to further interaction between youth across the nation.
