MONTREAL (CP)—The U. S. dollar closed Tuesday at a discount of 1-33-32 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 1-8. It footed 98-9-32 cents Canadian to buy 1 American. Pound sterling \$277 1-16, up 9-16.

WINNIPEG (CP)—Moderate export interest in flax was the only feature in trade Tuesday on the Winnipeg grain exchange. Prices showed some hesitation in response to the easier tone of U. S. markets. Overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat included: Malta 380,000 bushels, Brazil 370,000, Israeli 370,000, the Netherlands 380,000, Switzerland 106,000, Ecuador 55,000 and a small parcel to Colombia. Lacked prices for top grades of class two, IWA and domestic wheat were up one-eighth cent except for class two durums which were unchanged.
