use for a dessert cheese treat. For them I suggest my latest creation—deviled cheese balls. Deviled Cheese Balls: Fine-shred or grate enough sharp Cheddar to make 1/2 c. Mix in 3 oz. cream cheese, 1 c. plain cottage cheese, 1 tsp. mild chutney, 1 tsp. mild vinegar and 4 drops Tabasco. Chill. Form into marble-sized balls and place on very small whole wheat crackers.

All measurements are level; recipes proportioned to serve 4-6. Crabmeat Marinara: Combine 1-1/2 tsp. cayenne pepper, 1/2 tsp. onion powder, 1/4 tsp. garlic powder, 1/4 tsp. powdered basil, 1/2 tsp. salt, 1/4 tsp. sugar, 1 c. olive oil, 2 tsp. chopped parsley and 8 peeled, diced, medium-fresh tomatoes. Mix and simmer - boil uncovered for 20 min., or until thick. Add the contents 2 (6-oz.) cans crabmeat (all shell removed). Simmer 5 min. Serve over plain or curried rice.

German Will Write On Canada

EDMONTON (CP)—Mrs. Grete Paquin of Goettingen, Germany, at 80 a grandmother of eight, has reached here on a journey which will eventually take her to Venezuela.

Since she left her home in the quiet German university town last October, Mrs. Paquin has worked as a dishwasher, children's nurse and bank clerk. She has travelled extensively in Canada and the United States.

By the time her trip is completed, the university instructor and graduate of Berlin and Zurich universities, will have visited Mexico and South America. The Canadian tour will provide material for a book about Canadians for Germans.

Before coming to Edmonton Mrs. Paquin spent several weeks in Uranium City in northwestern Saskatchewan where she was a relief bank clerk. While there she gave an organ recital of old German folk songs.

I attended the 12th session of the Narcotics Commission which is attempting to help bring about the international control of the illicit trade in narcotics. Canada is one of the nations represented on the Commission; among the others are the United States, China, Egypt, France, India, Iran, Mexico, the Netherlands, and the Soviet Union.
