# Lobster Carnival has gala full week of fun

The Summerside Lobster Carnival, July 15 - 21, offers six days of fun, entertainment, and delicious lobster suppers.

From the Island's largest street parade of floats, bands, and pretty girls which signal the start of the week-long program, until its conclusion with the selection and crowning of a new "Miss Prince Edward Island" on the final night of the carnival, each day and evening is highlighted by a constant change in program.

The carnival is the climax of a full year of planning, and the direct or indirect participation of almost everyone of the town's 9,000 persons.

For the visitor it offers just about everything to make it an interesting and enjoyable part of their summer holidays, with each day's program filled with events to interest all ages, and every member of the family.

**LARGEST DISPLAY**  
 The fisheries display this year will be the largest ever seen in Eastern Canada, with a \$8,000 set of observation tanks containing a wide variety of live, fresh and salt water fish and sea life such as lobster, trout, salmon, cod, mackerel, etc., and displays of tropical fish.

For lovers of old-time music with a modern presentation, carnival officials have obtained the best in Canada, and CBC-TV's Don Messer and his Islanders, along with the popular Ructa Dancers, will be one of the attractions on the final day of the carnival.

For visitors who look to this province for the thrills of sultry- drawn horse racing, there are six nights of race programs including a \$2,500 free-for-all. About 150 horses are expected to participate in the various race events at the Summerside track, adjacent to the carnival headquarters in Summerside Stadium, during Carnival Week.

**LOVELY LASSIES**  
 The "Miss Prince Edward Island" contest features some of the loveliest lassies on the island, who are seen first in the opening day parade, and again each evening throughout Carnival Week until the final selection of "Miss P.E.I." and her two princesses on Friday evening, and the coronation performed the final night by last year's carnival queen, followed by a big Coronation Ball.

The colorful high-stepping Summerside majorettes will head up the big parade of about 60 floats, several bands, and marching units forming at marling wharf and moving along a flag-draped parade route offering countless opportunities for lively, action-filled pictures by the spectators along the parade route.

Adding to the nautical flavor of the carnival atmosphere, four navy ships, Canadian and American, are expected to be in Summerside throughout the carnival period. The ships will be open to public inspection at various times, and the sailors participate in carnival events including the parade, track and field program, and these boys in navy blue enjoy the week-long carnival while being a part of it.

A children's day program offers fun, games, and prizes for the young members of the family, along with a doll carriage parade, and a real live baby contest. There is also a drawing for bicycles which creates a lot of interest and hope in the youngsters who also get to see a special showing of the feature acts presented daily at the carnival.

**LEADING TALENT**  
 These feature acts, always of high interest and very entertaining, are drawn from some of the best acts in the country; many of them have appeared on the Ed Sullivan Show.

Along with the carnival is a two-day livestock exhibition where the best of Island cattle, and horses, are judged and seen on parade.

An exciting program featuring an invitation track-and-field meet will provide a complete range of events for both male and female participants from pole vaulting to distance running.

The carnival golf tournament will commence on Saturday at the Summerside Golf and Country Club and will conclude on Sunday, with entries received up to the commencement of the tournament.

The carnival headquarters at the Summerside Stadium is the focal point of most of the carnival events, and it is here that the delicious, delightful lobster suppers are served, as well as fried chicken for those who prefer it.

In addition to the fascinating display of live fish, there will be exhibits by Island commercial fish processing firms of fresh, frozen, and canned fish products.

**WILD LIFE DISPLAY**  
 An interesting part of the display at the stadium will be one on wild life, with practically all native birds and animals on display, along with other interesting exhibits relating to animal and bird wild life.

The Women's Institutes will conduct an exhibition of handicraft work from quilts to needlework, much of this fine work was offered for public sale after judging.

This year the "Maple Tree Craft" woodworking display and demonstration will be one of the feature attractions of the carnival, where the Leavitt family of Alberta, who have turned a hobby into a nationally recognized business, will make their first public display and demonstration of their craftsmanship at an event of this kind.

The entire stadium floor will be occupied by various booths illustrating other subjects of outstanding interest in the agricultural, fishing, and commercial life of Prince Edward Island.

Adjacent to the carnival headquarters in the stadium will be the largest midway that has been located at any of the lobster carnival programs that continue to be the most spectacular and enjoyable annual community attraction at Summerside.

**Suspect isn't telling**  
 NEW YORK (CP)—Douglas Brown has told reporters that he knows the whereabouts of money still missing from the theft in Vancouver last week-end of more than \$500,000 from the Loomis Armored Car Service. Brown was interviewed on arrival here Saturday from Rio de Janeiro on his way back to Vancouver in custody of an airport policeman. A Loomis driver, Brown disappeared after the theft in the stadium to Rio. In answer to a question, he said he has not revealed the whereabouts of \$255,000 Vancouver police say still is missing. "They're after the money; I know where it is," he said. "That's for me to know and you to find out," he replied.
