RALLY—THIS EVENING.

PERRY'S PECULIAR POSITION.

MR. STANISLAUS F. PERRY, member of the Provincial Legislature, elect, was nominated, to-day, a candidate for the representation of Prince County in the House of Commons.

This action of his is clearly and notoriously in direct opposition to the law of the land.

It is a well known fact that no man can at the same time be a member of the Local Legislature and a candidate for the House of Commons.

It is equally well known that a man who has been elected a member of the Local Legislature cannot resign the trust imposed upon him by the electors until after the first meeting of the Legislature, and that only death or acceptance of office can vacate the seat.

The law on this point has been laid down by Mr. L. H. Davies and other practitioners, and has been established by the decisions of our highest courts and by Parliament itself.

In 1876, Mr. L. H. Davies, then Attorney-General for the Province, gave a written opinion in the case of Mr. William Welsh. His opinion on the point will, we have no doubt, be regarded as decisive by all electors who acknowledge him as their political leader.

Mr. Davies' opinion is contained in a letter to the Provincial Secretary of the day, a copy of which we here publish *verbatim et literatim*:

[COPY.]

ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE, November 24th, 1876.

"Sir,—In reply to your letter of the 27th November, instant, enclosing a copy of a resignation by William Welsh, Esq., of his seat in the House of Assembly as member elect for the Fourth Electoral District of Queen's County, together with a copy of the notification to the Lieutenant-Governor from the two members elect who received the resignation of their receipt of the same, and requesting my opinion whether, under the peculiar circumstances of the case, Mr. Welsh's seat can be considered legally vacant, and the Lieutenant-Governor be authorized to direct a writ of Election to issue to fill the alleged vacancy, I beg to say that the Act passed during the last session of the late House of Assembly, intitled, "An Act further securing the independence of the General Assembly," declares the circumstances under which the seats of members of the House of Assembly can become vacant. The only provisions made for vacancies occurring between the General Election and the first meeting of the General Assembly is contained in the 15th section. That section provides for vacancies caused by death or acceptance of office.

"It is limited to those two cases; and in my opinion the seat of any member elect to the House of Assembly cannot become vacant until the meeting of the General Assembly, excepting under one of two states of facts mentioned in that section, viz., death or acceptance of office.

"The 15th section of the same Act only applies to the interval between two sessions of the Assembly, and not to the interval between a General Election and the first meeting of the Legislature. I do not, therefore, think that Mr. Welsh has, under the peculiar circumstances of this case, power voluntarily to resign, or that there is a vacancy which the Lieutenant-Governor is authorized to direct a writ to issue to fill.

"I have the honor to be, sir, Your obedient servant, (Signed) 'LOUIS H. DAVIES, Attorney General.' To the Hon. the Provincial Secretary.

Since this letter was written, the question has been fully tested in the case of Dr. Robertson.

Now, Messrs. Lefurgey and Ferguson have both resigned their positions in the Provincial Government, and have accepted office. Consequently their seats have become legally vacant, and they are free to contest the election.

But Mr. Perry has not accepted an office, and therefore he is still a member elect of the Provincial Legislature. Consequently his nomination is, without doubt, illegal.

Every ballot cast for Mr. Perry will be thrown away!

Before the election of 1882 THE EXAMINER warned the electors of King's County that those who voted for Dr. Robertson would lose their votes,—and they did. It remains to be seen whether or not the electors of Prince County will now, despite our warning, make the same mistake.

Mr. Perry is not sinning ignorantly. We cannot suppose that he is so utterly wanting in ability as to innocently blunder as Dr. Robertson did in 1882. Therefore we must conclude that he is, knowingly a mere cat-paw of Mr. James Yeo. Will the intelligent electors of Prince County be party to such a "little game"? We think not.

—How utterly demoralized and reckless the Patriot is, may be judged from the fact that it published yesterday what purported to be a telegram from Souris, in which it was stated that "The largest meeting ever held took place in Souris today!"
