TORONTO, (CP) - Stock market prices Thursday continued recent declines, led by base metals. Volume totalled 3,914,000 shares. New Norzone traded more than 690,000 shares to gain one-half a cent; Bonville moved 456,000 shares for a 12-cent gain, and Brunhild traded 422,000 shares to lose eight cents. New Brunswick base metals and uranium slipped. Noranda led higher-priced base metals lower with a loss of 75 cents. Normetals, Golden Manitou and United Keno traded lower. Campbell Chibougama and Cobalt Cons. added 20 cents each. In Western oils Canada Southern, Stanwell and Pacific slipped. Gainers were Sapphires, Home and Britalia.

Senior golds slipped as Dome lost almost 1/2 while juniors turned mixed. Donald and Barnat gained and San Antonio and Pickie Crow slipped.

MONTREAL, (CP) - The stock market was generally lower at the close of a dull session Thursday. Senior metals and papers bore the brunt of the downward swing. Aluminum moved off 2 1/2 points to 45, Hudson Bay Mining was down one point at 49 1/2, Powell River lost 1 3/8 points to 20 1/8 and International Paper decreased 1 1/4 points to 49 3/4. Industrial Acceptance, Price Brothers, Walker, Noranda, Imperial Oil, Massey-Harris and CPR were lower. Canadian Celanese, Consolidated Smelters, Canadian Car and Galtineau slipped. In mines New Larder was off 15 cents at \$1.53 while Carnegie, Sisco, Western Tungsten and Chimo receded pennies. Western oils were generally depressed, despite a 25-cent advance by Home to \$9. Central Explorers, Empire Petroleum, Pacific Petroleum and Western Homestead receded.

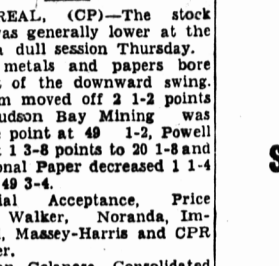
