TORONTO, (CP)—Stock market prices moved slowly lower Thursday, continuing a three-week decline. Base metals dropped and golds and Western oils also slipped. Volume totalled 2,819,000 shares. Uranium slipped and Bonville dropped pennies in a turnover of 397,000 shares. New Brunswick base metals were mixed as New Larder U slipped and Brunswick added a fraction. Higher-prices base metals weakened as Noranda and Hudson Bay dropped. Noranda, Anacon, Barvue and Dominion Asbestos also were down. Minda Scotia and Fenimore added pennies while Eastern Metals slipped. Federated was a standout in Western oils, gaining 80 cents in a turnover of 34,000 shares. United also rose but Royalite, Okalta, Husky, Gridoil and Banff weakened. Senior golds weakened as McIntyre, Kerr Addison, and Dome slipped, holding companies rose. Junior producers were mixed. Sullivan added pennies and East Malartic traded lower.

New York Stocks

NEW YORK, (AP)—The stock market dropped to a new average low for the year Thursday as last-minute selling wiped an estimated \$1,250,000,000 from quoted prices. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks declined \$1.30 to close at \$107.20, the lowest point reached since last Nov. 6. Transactions totalled 1,920,000. In the Associated Press average, industrial stocks lost \$1.50, rails \$1.40 and utilities 50 cents. Goodrich was off 1 1/8 at 66 and Goodyear 7-8 at 52 1/8. Sears, Roebuck led 1 at 56 1-4. Canadian issues were lower. McIntyre was down one to 63, Canadian Pacific dropped 1-4, Dome Mines was down 3-8 and Hiram Walker dropped 1-2. International Nickel and Distillers Seagram both slipped 5-8. On the American stock exchange, Giant Yellowknife and Royalite Oil both dropped 1-8; Lake Shore was off 1-4.

The lower tone was paced by Canada Cement, down two points at 76, Hudson Bay Mining and Dominion Bridge, off 1 1/2 at 44 1-2 and 73 1-2, respectively, and Noranda, off 1 1/4 at 66 3/4. Senior metals, papers, steels, miscellaneous industrials, beverages and carriers backed up. Lower were Gypsum, International Paper, Shawinigan, Canadian Brewers, International Nickel, Cocksouth, CPR and Bank of Montreal. In mines Chimo lost 40 cents at \$3.25, Steep Rock and Dominion Asbestos dipped 15 cents to \$5.85 and \$3.28, respectively, while Anacon, Carnegie and East Sullivan decreased smaller figures. Empire Oils provided the feature in Western oils, rising 22 cents to 75 cents. Gaspe, Del Rio and Pacific Petroleum receded. Industrial volume was 58,200 shares and mines 401,200.
