**Suggests Centre For Retired Church Ministers**

By CRAIG ARMSTRONG (Canadian Press Staff Writer) HAMILTON, Ont., Sept. 18.—(CP)—A community centre for retired ministers was suggested Wednesday to the General Council of the Pensions Board. In presenting the report of the Pension Fund, Dr. Tuttle said: "Equally important as the cash pension is the need for a comfortable and inexpensive place to live for all who have been unable to make such provision for themselves... a life of self-sacrificing service calls for a lifetime of sacrificial support."

"Is this too much to expect from the United Church of Canada?" he asked. "A community with individual cottages and a main building is the ideal plan. We would be extremely happy to begin with the main building and add the cottages as our resources make it possible."

Dr. Tuttle said he had visited such projects in Des Moines, Iowa, and Claremont, Calif. at Des Moines the Methodist Church was building a planned community for ordained and lay workers of the church.

There he said, individual cottages and a main building are being built. The main building contained an infirmary, a library, a chapel and about 200 private rooms. The cottages are the homes of the pensioners and their wives. The rooms in the main building would be used by widows and widowers.

**British Films Had Good Year Here**

LONDON, Sept. 18.—(CP)—The report of the J. Arthur Rank Organization for the 53 weeks ending June 28, says that "remittances from the distribution of British films by our Canadian organization were, during the year, the highest we have ever received."

Net revenue from "exhibition overseas," which means revenue from theatres, as distinct from films, in the Commonwealth theatre groups, including Canada, was \$465,004, compared with \$268,548 in the preceding 53 weeks.

Net loss on film production and distribution was down to \$146,515, compared with a loss of \$1,314,829 in 1951 and \$2,137,991 in 1950.

Trading profit of the organization was \$5,047,104, an increase of one-third over 1951.

Bank advances of Odeon Theatres, Ltd., and its subsidiaries was reduced by \$2,437,008, to make a total repayment in three years of approximately \$9,500,000.

Loan capital (mortgages, debentures, etc.) was reduced by \$1,911,275.
