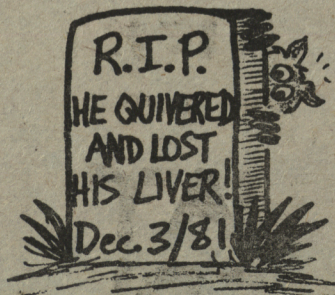
No seriously.
