WINNIPEG, Dec. 18 - (CP) - Process generally took on a lower trend in the last half of trading today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange after showing a fairly steady tone early in the moderately-active session.

The declines came in sympathy with weaknesses on United States markets.

Earlier commercial demand had been fairly aggressive and included some export buying in barley in connection with the sale of 500,000 bushels of this commodity to the continent.

American demand appeared in oats and flax. Local and outside selling sent rye downward.

No information was available on export wheat loadings.

Prices for class two wheat and I. W. A. advanced one-quarter cent from yesterday.

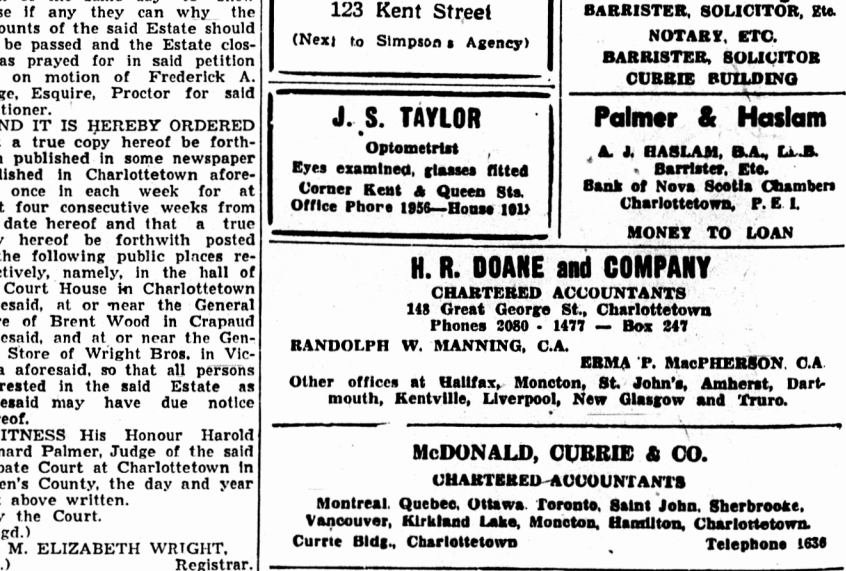
