If a glass stopper is hard to remove, a little glycerine poured around the neck of the stopper will loosen it.

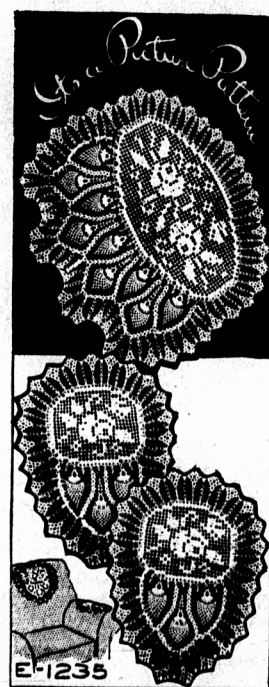
Kid Gloves

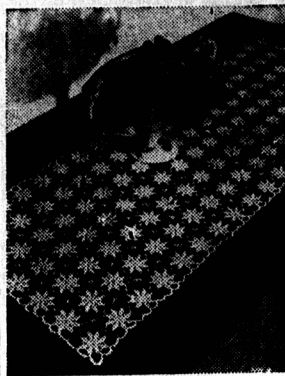
Modern Etiquette

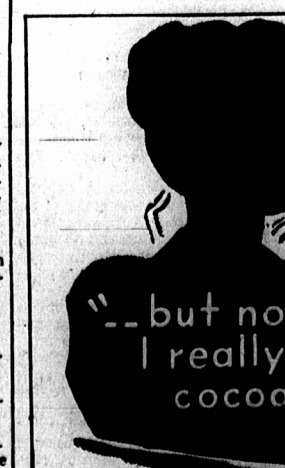

Cook's Corner

MARBLE CAKE

A very light and tender cake, with a delicate crumb and a thin sweet crust. Cake flour—which we definitely call for in our recipe—is largely responsible for the character of the cake.

1 1/2 ounces unsweetened chocolate 2 cups once-sifted cake flour 3 teaspoons baking powder 1/2 teaspoon salt 8 tablespoons butter or margarine 1 1/4 cups fine granulated sugar 3/4 cup milk 1 teaspoon vanilla 3 egg whites 2 tablespoons granulated sugar 3 tablespoons water 3/4 teaspoon almond flavoring 1/4 teaspoon baking soda

Measure and sift together twice, the flour, baking powder and salt. Cream the butter or margarine and gradually blend in 1 cup of the sugar; cream well. Combine the milk and vanilla. Very gradually stir a little of the flavored milk into creamed mixture.

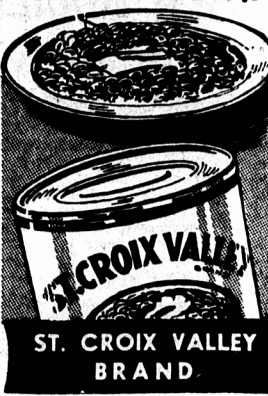

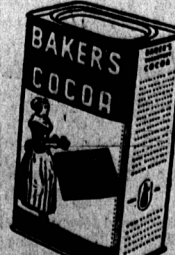
