 Massey-Ferguson closed unchanged at 34 and Bell Telephone was up 1/4 at 50 1/2.
 Among other fairly active issues, Dominion Glass lost 1/2 at 15 1/2, Brinco was up 1/2 at 3 1/2 and International Nickel was unchanged at 96 1/2.
 CPR gained 1/4 at 81 and Walker-Gooderham, at 29 1/2, was also up 1/4. Du Pont lost 1/4 at 42.

 TORONTO (CP)—The Toronto Stock Exchange rebounded from two days of losses Wednesday with all major sections showing strength.
 The recovery followed the trend at New York which analysts attributed to a technical rebound from nervous selling.
 Volume improved moderately as a result of increased speculative activity. A total of 2,687,000 shares were traded compared with 2,594,000 Tuesday.
 In the main list, Alcan was ahead 1/2 to 34 1/2 and Walkers 1/2 to 29 1/2.
 Canadian Breweries slipped 1/4 to 6 1/2 on 22,995 shares and Levy 1/4 to 18 1/4.
 Price highlighted speculative activity, climbing 17 cents to 3.10 on 242,913 shares.
 Labrador Mining paced base metals, gaining 1 1/4 to 27 1/2 while Rio Algom declined 1/4 to 28 1/2.
 Advances outnumbered red declines 246 to 162 with 201 issues unchanged.
 On index, industrials were up 59 to 158.60, golds 2.26 to 186.83, base metals 73 to 97.60, western oils 32 to 101.40 and the TSE 61 to 151.37.

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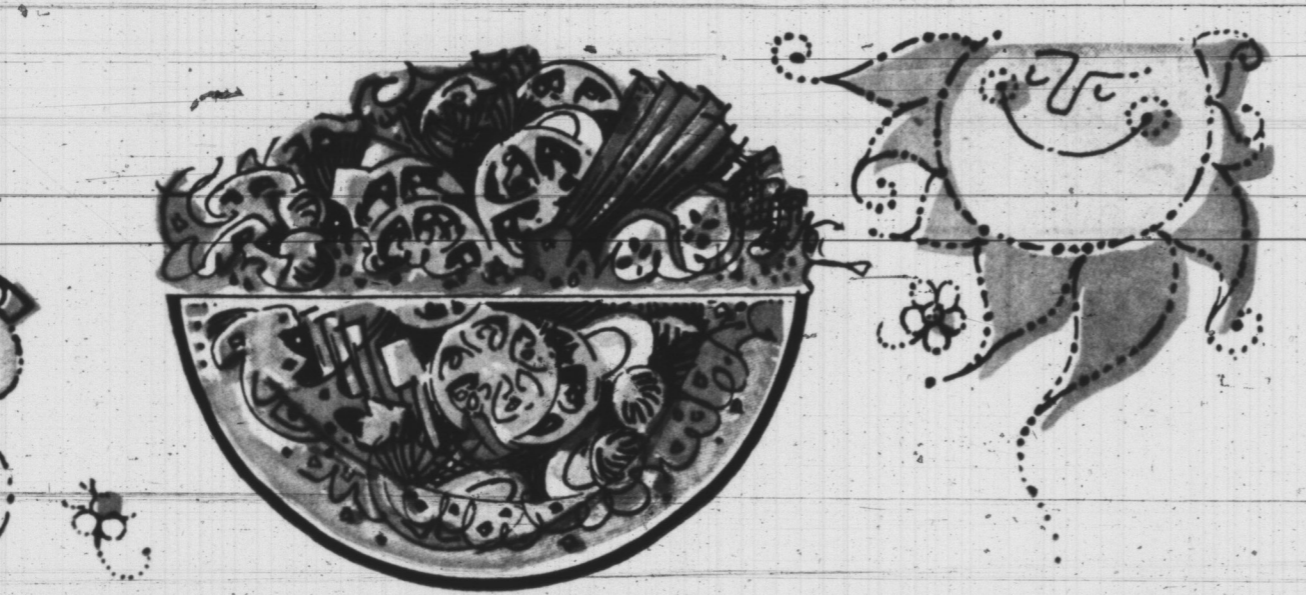
