WHAT OLD MR. TOAD SAW every night hunting for, and eating, worms and insects that are eating the leaves of the plants. He is a sort of garden policeman.

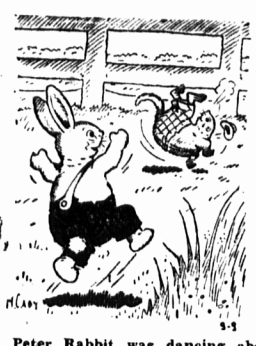
