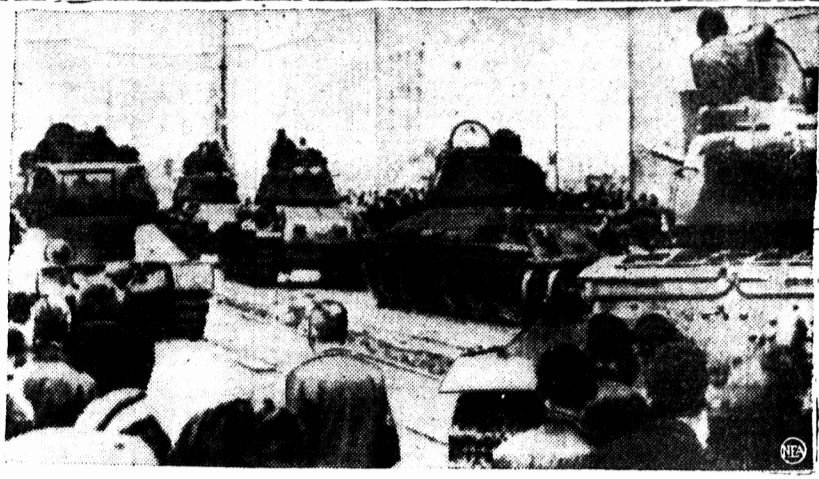
The death occurred at the King's County Memorial Hospital, Montague, May 13th, of Mr. Walter N. Myers of Cardigan, after a short illness.

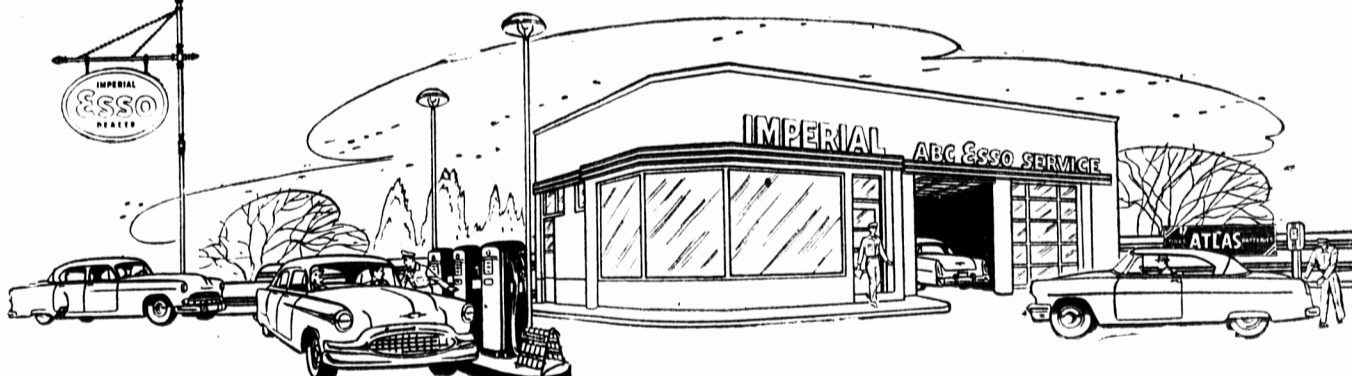

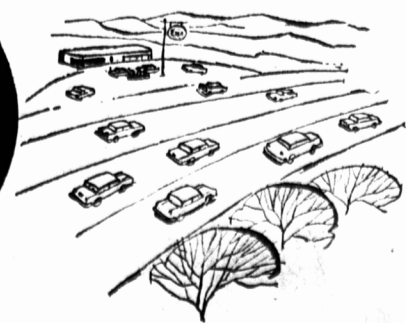
