GRAIN

WINNIPEG, Sept. 17-(CP)—Little change was recorded by wheat futures prices after an irregular session on Winnipeg grain exchange Saturday.

Alternatively influenced by moderate offerings and light mill and export support quotations fluctuated nervously before closing 1-1-1-8 cent lower, Oct. at 77, Nov. 78-5-9A, Dec. 78 3-4-7-8 and May 83 cents.

Lack of available supplies again curbed business in the cash wheat market.

COIN MAY POINT WAY TO TREASURE

LUNenburg, N. S., Sept. 16.—Discovery of an ancient English coin on Heister's Island has suggested the possibility of finding buried treasure on the little isle.

Transfers for the two hours totalled 1,084,374 shares. Principal share losers, included U. S. Steel, Bethlehem, General Motors, Chrysler, Anaconda, American Smelting, Douglas Aircraft, Westinghouse, DuPont, Allied Chemical, Texas Corp., International Harvester and Montgomery Ward.

Among Dominion issues, Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines were the most active. Distillers Corp.-Seagrams added a fraction, Canada 45 in the bond market were off 1-1-4.

U. S. Steel shares, most active of any issue during the week, kept the major portion of its gains, being up 7 points net at 76 7-8 in the 6 days.

LARGEST N. B. RESERVATION IS GROWING

PERTH N. B., Sept. 16.—The population of Malisee, largest Indian reservation in New Brunswick, has increased by 100 in the last ten years. Its total is 325.

Beautifully situated at the junction of the St. John and Tobique rivers, Malisee covers an area of nearly 400 acres of woodland. It is the only reserve in the Maritime Provinces to have its own hospital.

It contains the hospital and a two-room school are supervised by sisters of charity. The hospital, built in 1924, also serves as a home. Officials hope to convert the institution into a sanatorium and build an annex for a sisters' residence.

Malisee still follow the old custom of electing a chief. Present chief, recently re-elected for a three-year term with Solomon Bear and Louis Sappier as councillors.

Mer Electa, mother superior and nurse, has developed a large weaving class of older girls in the community. They weave garments, materials for drapes, etc. and receive a complete set of uniforms for the Malisee baseball team.

This team, long famous in northern New Brunswick and Maine for its high calibre play, competes with the best teams in the district.

The reserve is noted for several good fishing pools which provide employment for about 100 Indians as guides. The Malisees are excellent canoeists and fishermen. One of the tribe's main sources of revenue is derived from the manufacture of baskets, verandah furniture and other Indian handicraft.

Since 1921 clergy of the Franciscan Order have been in charge of the community. Father Bernard Nobert is the present resident priest.
