MONTREAL (CP) — The U.S. dollar closed Monday at a discount of 1.9-1.6 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, up 1-16. Pound sterling \$2.77, unchanged.

### TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) — Investors speculative mining issues went on a trading spree Monday and boosted the stock market's volume to its heaviest in three months.  
New Mylamarque was the most active stock, adding eight cents to 36 cents. Other active mines included Brunhurst, up 1/2 cents to seven cents; Indian Lake, up one cent to nine cents; New Goldview, up 3/4 cents to 8 cents and Norynque, up 1/2 cents to 13 cents.  
Senior base metals, golds and uranium were mixed to lower but trading in these groups was heavier but in a narrow range.  
Index changes: Golds up .19 to 71.99; base metals off .06 to 148.01; western oils up .82 to 133.80.
