### Russia Moves Whole Villages In Vast Scheme

What happens to the average Russian peasant under the new, vast collectivization program?

In its drive for ever-greater production, Russia is compressing its collective farms into huge amalgamated units, moving hundreds of villages, uprooting millions of homes, and planning to squeeze the last ounce out of each farmer in the greatest program of regimentation ever known.

Moscow Province already has cut the number of its collectives from 6,000 to 1,500, by amalgamation. Altai Province has compressed 4,200 into 1,400—each of 300 households or more.

In Kalkin Province, the program is just beginning, and Pravda has carried an explanation by the Modino collective farm chairman. Only five smaller collective farms have been amalgamated there thus far but here is what the farmer is up against:

The four other villages are being collective. This means the 112 homes of the collective farm families, mostly one-room affairs, must be dismantled and taken to Moldino.

The householder being moved must pay the cost of any building materials needed to set up his new home as well as the expense of dismantling and reassembling his home.

The plot of land he will have all to himself will be about a third of an acre. On the plot he will be required to plant orchard trees in addition to his small vegetable garden.

He will work in a "brigade" composed of men and women farmers. Much of their pay will be in produce, the amount depending upon how much they grow.

### First Quiet In Iran Rioting

TEHRAN, Iran, April 18 (AP)—The Iranian Senate today unanimously supported with a vote of confidence the policies of Premier Hussein Ala in handling the crisis over this country's vast oil wealth.

Ala also has asked the Majlis (Lower House of Parliament) for a vote of confidence. This was delayed last week when angry national front members—vanguard of the move to nationalize Iran's oil including the huge British-controlled holdings of the Anglo-Iranian oil company—walked out, leaving the house without a quorum.

The Senate's vote reaffirmed approval of Ala as tension in the strike-and riot-ridden southern-oil fields eased.

A show of force by tank-led troops in Abadan, scene of the world's largest oil refineries, brought the first quiet to the 130,000 inhabitants since bloody rioting last Thursday caused the death of three Britons and six Iranians.

Strict curfew measures forbade gatherings of more than five persons after the troops yesterday broke up a demonstration of 4,000 strike sympathizers.

Although only 800 apprentices actually are striking in the Abadan refineries, only some 3,200 of the 12,000 employed in the Anglo-Iranian company's big works had returned to their jobs. Company officials hoped that the back-to-work movement would spread to all the workers within the next two days.
