Steel Output In U.S. Estimated For Next Year

CLEVELAND (AP)—Steel Magazine says that estimates of next year's total steel ingot production range from 106,000,000 to 115,000,000 tons.

By comparison, 1955 was the record year at 117,000,000 tons, less over the output was 115,000,000 and this year it will be about 114,000,000.

"If output next year falls in the middle of the range now estimated it will be only about 5 per cent below the 1955 high," comments the weekly trade journal.

Steel says "most steelmen are looking to consumer goods, notably automobiles, to generate demand early in the new year to support steelmaking operations."

"Construction, off seasonally, should rise a net quarter. Construction demand (which would be 1/3rd partially by growing building activity) will be a few cents more by mid-1958 as needs."

The magazine's composite price index for steel in 1957 was 132.33, a new low since mid-October, 1954.

Corporations To Get Some Relief

OTTAWA (CP)—Canadian corporations will get minor tax relief starting in 1958.

The corporation income tax rate now is 20 per cent on taxable income and 47 per cent on all profits in excess of \$20,000.

Finance Minister Donald Fleming announced Friday night in the Commons that the \$20,000 exemption will be increased to \$25,000 effective next Jan. 1.

In effect, all corporations with profits in excess of \$25,000 will see a reduction in tax of 11 1/2 per cent a year.

At present, a corporation with \$25,000 gross pays income tax of \$6,250. Under the new formula its tax bill will be \$5,000.

The change will cost the treasury \$120,000,000 in a full year and about \$100,000,000 in the next fiscal year which ends next March 31.

Mr. Fleming said the government expects the proposed changes will be a stimulus to small Canadian businesses.
