U. N. Not Offering Jobs in Kashmir

UNITED NATIONS, N. Y., Oct. 9 - (CP) - The United Nations secretary has discovered that dozens of Vancouverites want to ride over mountain trails as high as 19,000 feet and undertake six-week expeditions by jeep in Kashmir. That's part of the job described in three paragraphs by the Vancouver Province recently. The newspaper said former officers with good war records could apply to the U. N. for a job on the staff of the U. N. Mediation Mission to Kashmir, a small state in the Himalayas over which India and Pakistan have been arguing for years.

GRAIN

WINNIPEG, Oct. 9 - (CP) - Prices moved lower - some sharply - in dull trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, reflecting lack of aggressive demand and increased offerings also were factors in the trade. Some routine shipper demand appeared in oats and barley, while the deferred months of barley came in for some export buying. No export business was confirmed.

Seaboard and commission houses were buyers on recessions. Flax and rye trade was local, with prices moving lower in sympathy with other grains. Flax and rye were sharply lower.

Export loadings of Canadian wheat included 365,000 bushels for Belgium, 450,000 or Germany, 60,000 for the United Kingdom, 80,000 for Bolivia, 465,000 for Switzerland and 400,000 for the Netherlands.

Prices for class two wheat were down one-half cent from yesterday, while I.W.A. prices were up one-half cent.
