

A Sketch of Lady Florence Dixie's Life.

Lady Florence Dixie's last contribution to the discussion of Irish affairs in the public journals was a letter to the London Times, dated March 8th, in which she had charged that Messrs. Parnell and Biggar, as trustees of the Land League funds, had failed to account for £152,000, and asserted that they were mocking the sufferings of the Irish people by a sham championship of a starving peasantry.

Lady Florence Dixie is the youngest of the eccentric family. She married in 1875, Sir Alexander Beaumont Churchill Dixie, Bart. She is famous as a horsewoman, as a sailor, as a traveller, and as an impetuous writer, and was special correspondent in Zululand for the Morning Post.

In Irish matters she has taken the greatest interest. She got into controversy with the Land League by publishing a pamphlet entitled "An Address to the Tenant Farmers and People of Ireland, with Advice and Warning," in which she urged them to demand from the trustees a statement of the receipts and expenditures of the Land League funds.
