BURNETT OF TOMBSTONE.

County Cut Down His Bill, and He Ran the Court to Suit Himself. A stormy life was that ended when old Jim Burnett was killed in Tombstone by William Greene—a life full of experiences of the border kind that would supply material for 20 of the most thrilling of the yellow backed novels.

Since Burnett's death many are the tales being raked up about him. His was a singular personality. Strong willed and violent in temper, he especially shone in a frontier camp. It was, therefore, quite appropriate that he should have been elected justice of the peace in 1881 at Charleston, on the San Pedro, where the rich ores of Tombstone were at that time mined.

One day old man Schwartz got excited and killed a man. After the justice, an ex-officio coroner, had finished the inquest he had Schwartz haled before the bar, found him guilty of the crime and fined him \$1,000. Schwartz wanted to appeal the case, but Burnett would issue no papers on appeal. So the defendant sent up to Tombstone for Attorney Mark Smith, now delegate to congress from Arizona. Smith came down at once and heard Schwartz's tale of woe.
