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DAMAGE BY EARTHQUAKE.

Signor Galli, the Royal Commissioner, appointed to visit the districts affected by the recent earthquake in Italy, has visited Reggio, the capital of the province of Reggio Calabria, and reports that he found in the city only twenty houses that had escaped damage.

Another sharp earthquake was felt in Reggio on Thursday. The interiors of whole rows of houses in a space three hundred yards long were completely wrecked.

Many homeless women and children are wandering about their ruined dwellings, wringing their hands and weeping bitterly.

The persons injured by falling ceilings and other accidents are being attended to in the open square. Many domestic families from the rural towns are pillaging the damaged shops and houses.

Troops have been posted throughout the unfortunate districts to protect property. The Pope has provided a fund for the assistance of the sufferers.
