SETTLING TOO CHEAPLY

Faulty defense gave a certain East-West pair a near "zero" on a deal played at match-point duplicate.

West dealer. Both sides vulnerable. Match-point duplicate.

♠ 10 9 3	♥ A K 7 2	♦ 6 5 3	♣ A 10
♠ A K 7 4	♥ 8 5 3	♦ A Q 10	♣ K 4 2
♠ J 2	♥ Q 9 6 4	♦ K J 7 2	♣ Q 6 3
♠ 3 6 5	♥ J 10	♦ 9 8 4	♣ J 9 8 7 5

Remarkably enough, at three different tables this was the bidding:

West	North	East	South
1 ♠	Pass	1 NT	Pass
Pass	Dble.	Redbl.	2 ♣
Dble.	Pass	Pass	Pass

In one case where this was the auction, the play proceeded as follows:

West opened the spade king, and when East, starting a high-low, played the jack, West continued with the ace and four of spades. East ruffed and returned the diamond deuce. (It might have been better for East to lay down the diamond king and then follow up in the suit, but the later explained) he wanted to give West an accurate count of diamonds.

West, after winning the trick with the diamond ten, made a bad mistake! Apparently thinking of nothing but "killing" dummy's spade trick. West led his last card of that suit for his partner to ruff. East, to avoid being over-ruffed by declarer, trumped with the club queen and of course took the trick, but South gladly seized the chance to get rid of a diamond. The upshot was that the defenders took only seven tricks, defeating the contract 500 points instead of 300. Since the larger penalty was collected at the other tables, while some East-Wests bid and made game, this particular pair of defenders did badly on the board.

If West had given the situation clear thought, he would have realized that East could not possibly have redoubled one notrump without the diamond king! Thus, West might have seen the necessity for cashing three rounds of diamonds immediately, and not wasting his time on killing dummy's spade trick.
