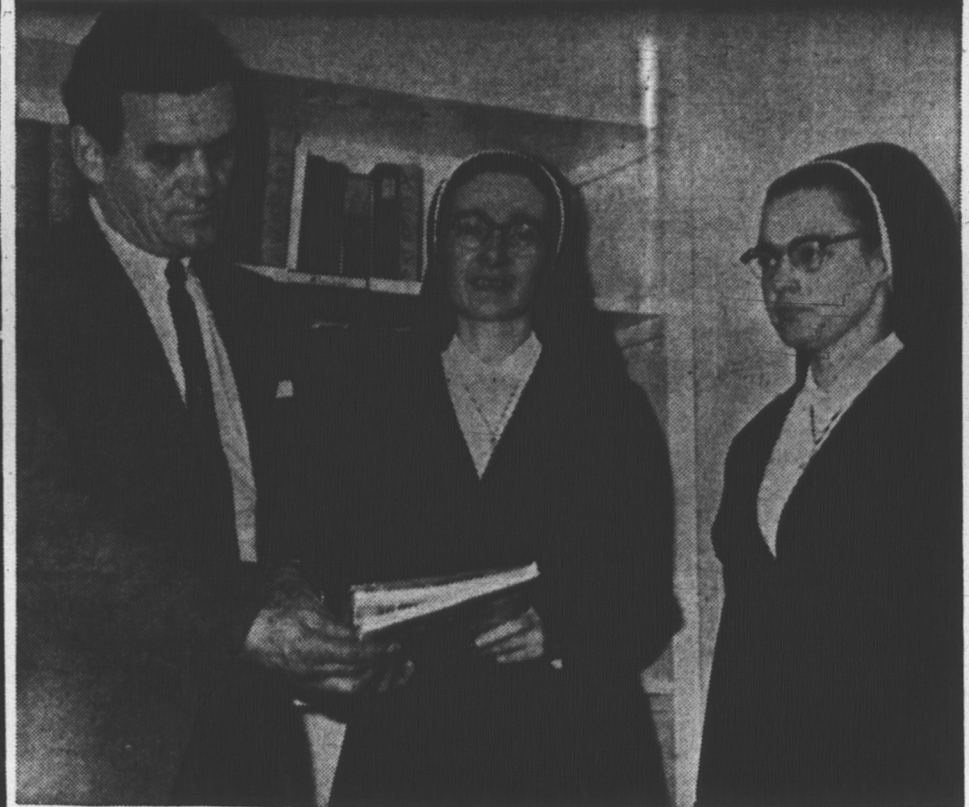

Tignish also has been honored to have three distinguished sons serve as Lt. Governors of P.E.I., Hon. George Howland, Sir Charles Dalton, Hon. Joseph A. Bernard. Tignish schools have educated other distinguished people including several in religious life, one being Most Rev. Bishop Leo Nelligan now of Pembroke, Ont.

New Blast At Moscow Is Loosed By Peking

TOKYO (AP) — Peking has loosed a new blast at Moscow accusing the Soviet Union of plotting with the United States to encircle China and to sell out the Vietnamese people. The Chinese denounced Russian "dirty deals," "tricks," and "chauvinism."

In a letter to Moscow broadcast by Radio Peking, the Chinese rejected an invitation to congress in Moscow Tuesday into the Soviet Communist party

terms so harsh as to seem to bring the two countries closer to an open split. Albania, Peking's only ally in Europe, also brusquely declined to go to Moscow.

The Chinese said the Russians distributed an anti-Chinese letter to world Communist parties recently and asked: "In these circumstances, how can the Chinese Communist party, which you look upon as an

enemy, be expected to attend your congress."

The Russian letter, as published in West Germany this week, accused the Chinese of trying to involve the Soviet Union in a war with the United States, of stirring up incidents on the Russian border and blocking Soviet arms aid to North Viet Nam. The Russians said the Chinese had rejected united action to resist the U.S. in Viet Nam.

CHINA RETORTS

Peking answered with this counter-blast:

"Despite the tricks you have been playing to deceive people, you are pursuing U.S.-Soviet collaboration for the domination of the world with your whole heart and soul."

Peking charged Moscow with working with the United States "in a whole series of dirty deals inside and outside the United Nations in 'a holy alliance against China.'"

The Chinese then referred specifically to the "anti-Chinese letter" to other parties, that Peking said was circulated about the time the Russians were initing the Chinese Feb. 24 to the congress.

The charges of "adventurism," "splittism," "Trotskyism" together with one that "China has been encroaching on Soviet territory," all show that the Soviet invitation to the Moscow congress "is merely a gesture and is sent with ulterior motives," the Chinese said.

NO MOSCOW REACTION

There was no reaction in Moscow to the stinging letter, which Peking said was sent Tuesday. But a Soviet press officer at the United Nations in New York said the Chinese refusal to attend the congress is "aimed at undermining the solidarity of peoples" struggling to maintain peace.

Diplomats in Moscow said the Chinese boycott of the congress puts North Viet Nam on the spot. North Viet Nam has tried to stay neutral in the Moscow-Peking ideological quarrel because it gets help from both sides.

When Alexander N. Shelepin, a Soviet party secretary, visited Hanoi in January the North Vietnamese accepted an invitation to the congress. Now they must decide on how many leaders can go without offending the Chinese.
