WINNIPEG, Feb. 20 - (CP) - Most prices showed a better tone today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange although early gains were not fully held.

Commercial demand was improved, with oats and barley receiving support from domestic shippers. Barley also was taken by seaboard interests. Processors picked up flax, while rye attracted some American demand early in the trade.

Late hesitation on United States markets was reflected locally in increased offerings.

No information was available on export loadings of Canadian wheat. I.W.A. and class two wheat prices remained unchanged.
