THE LATE JOHN L. CLARK Shortly before noon on Thursday, April 12th, the Angel of Death visited Rustico and claimed for its own the spirit of the late John L. Clark. Death came suddenly with a heart attack and he passed away before medical aid could reach him.

Although he suffered many periods of failing health during the past twenty years, when able he took an active part in affairs of the community and of the Province. Being of a very friendly personality, he made a wide circle of friends throughout the Province.

He was born in 1882, son of the late Lemuel and Jeannette (Houston) Clark. In 1914 he married Margaret Stevenson of New Glasgow, who predeceased him less than a year before. He was the youngest of a family of five, all of whom survive him.

His entire life was spent as a farmer on the family farm at Rustico where for twenty-five years he operated an Illustration Station in co-operation with the Experimental Farm. His outstanding ability as an agriculturist was recognized when he was made a member of the Order of the British Empire by the King.

Left to mourn his passing are two daughters, Jeannette, Mrs. Noel Hooper at home, and Edith, Mrs. Rob Emery now of Trenton, Ontario - three grandchildren, Marjorie and Nancy Hooper and Clark Emery - also his four sisters, Mrs. Annie Martin of Worcester, Mass., Mrs. Margaret Craswell and Miss Ella Clark of Rustico, and Miss Edith Clark of Charlottetown.

The funeral which was very largely attended was held from his residence on Sunday, April 15th. The service was conducted by Rev. George Tilley, assisted by Rev. A. E. Trevey. The music was under the direction of Mrs. Walter Buntain. Hymns sung were: "Unto the Hills" and "The Lord's My Shepherd." F/Lt. Ralph Emery sang as a solo, "In the Garden."

The Prince of Wales Masonic Lodge of which he was a member attended in a body and conducted its service at the house and at the grave.

The pall bearers were three neighbours, Cyril Tombs, Granville Buntain, Roland Buntain, and three cousins, Lorne Houston, Davis Moffatt and Leigh Warren. His remains were tenderly laid to rest in the New Glasgow Cemetery beside those of his wife.

Says Russian Jet Bombers Too Good WASHINGTON (AP) - Gen. Earl E. Partridge, chief of the continental air defence command, testified Friday Russia has bombers that his best fighter planes cannot match in speed and altitude.

The situation is being remedied by development of new U.S. fighters and missiles, Partridge told the Senate armed services subcommittee investigating relative Soviet and U.S. air power.

But in reference to what exists now, he said: "Between now and 1958, any attack by the Russians involving large numbers of jet aircraft would give us difficulties from an operational point of view."
