WAGES HIGHER

OTTAWA (CP)—Average wages in Canadian manufacturing plants rose to a new high in 1954 while the average work week fell to a new low. Average hourly wages increased to \$1.40 8-10 from \$1.35 8-10 in 1953 and weekly wages to \$57.16 from \$56.09, the bureau of statistics reported Monday. The work week dropped to 40.6 hours from 41.3, off his running shoes.
