It is our sad duty to chronicle the death of Mr. Lauchlin McPhee, which occurred on the 13th inst., at Glencorrodale, at the advanced age of 96 years.

He emigrated to Nova Scotia in 1842, where he received a license to teach school. He taught school at Sydney, C. B., for eleven years with great success, until he moved to this island in 1853.

He carried on the occupation of farming and teaching school for a number of years, until failing sight caused him to give up.

He succeeded in clearing a large farm and making a competence for himself and family. He leaves a wife, seven children and twenty-three grand children to mourn the loss of a kind parent.

He early cultivated habits of temperance, placing his passions under the control of the moral sentiments and direction of the intellectual faculties, always submitting his will to the law of God, which led him to a high state of perfection.

His remains were escorted by a long train of carriages to St. Columba church, where a High Mass of Requiem was celebrated by the pastor, Rev. A. J. McIntyre, after which his remains were taken to the cemetery, where the last sad rites of the departed were performed.
