THE COOK'S CORNER

Tomato Jelly Salad

- 2 cups tomato juice 1 small bay leaf 4 whole cloves 2 slices onion 1 teaspoon lemon juice 1 pkg. lemon jelly 1 cup minced celery 1 cup diced cucumber

Method: Simmer the tomato juice with the bay leaf, whole cloves and onion slices for 15 minutes. Strain and add the lemon juice and salt. Measure and if necessary add more hot tomato juice to make 2 full cups.

Chill until perfectly firm, then unmoild and serve on lettuce with mayonnaise or French dressing.

ORANGE CUP CAKES

- 1-2 cup shortening 1 cup sugar, scant measure 2 eggs 1 tsp. vanilla or 1-2 tsp. vanilla and 1-4 tsp. almond. 2 cups cake flour 3 tsp. baking powder

1-2 tsp. salt. Beat one large orange (grated) juice, one orange plus milk to make 1-2 cup. Walnut-cocoanut topping.

Beat the shortening and then add the sugar and cream well. Add the eggs which have been beaten until thick and lemon-colored. Then add the flavoring and the grated orange rind.

Beat the flour and measure and then sift several times with the baking powder and salt. Add the sifted ingredients alternately with the milk to the creamed mixture, folding in gently.

Divide the mixture between cup cake tins or paper cups. Add the topping. Bake at 375 deg. F. for 15 to 25 minutes, depending on the size of the cake.
