### Baked Brown Bread.

Two cups of graham flour, one cup of wheat flour, one half cup of sugar, one-half cup of molasses, two cups of sour milk or buttermilk, one teaspoonful of soda dissolved in a little hot water, one teaspoonful of salt. Put all together in a bowl and stir thoroughly. Put in a greased pail with a cover and bake four hours in a moderate oven.
