(SCI); **Common Redpoll** - 2 large flocks at Arlington in early Mar. (LP); **Pine Siskin** - at Arlington in early Mar. (LP); **American Goldfinch** - abundant at Charlottetown feeders on Apr. 26 (RAN); **Evening Grosbeak** - very few sightings this winter, 4 at Arlington feeder in early Mar. (LP), 1 on Mar. 13 & 6 on Apr. 6 at St. Charles's feeder (SFo via DO), 1 female at Donagh feeder on Apr. 12 (RPh), a female was calling in a maple tree in Crossroads on Apr. 24 after their unusual absence this past winter (DO), at Nail Pond feeder in May (LB); pair at New Dominion feeder on Jun. 3 (EMa), at Riverdale on May 8 (LD); **House Sparrow** - 10 males & females at Morell feeder on Apr. 1, 4 at St. Peter's on Apr. 1, 6 at Vickerson Road on Apr. 21 (DCS).
Older Reports: **Greater White-fronted Goose** at Lake Verde in early Oct., 2002 (SC via DO). Report of a **Golden Eagle** in Feb. at Cape Traverse George Reid via Dave Johnson). **Evening Grosbeak** - 2 at Marshfield eating native highbush cranberry and using white spruce in hedgerow (GK).
