LA GUERRE

Les délais du gouvernement et le caractère pacifique que conserve la guerre dans les Antilles, depuis un mois, commencent à faire naître une certaine indifférence parmi la population.

On ne sait plus que prévoir, on ne sait plus qu'attendre, les projets d'aujourd'hui sont renversés de main et l'absence d'un plan de campagne permettant au peuple d'en suivre le développement et les péripéties laisse l'intérêt s'endormir et l'enthousiasme qui se manifestait aux premiers jours, existe à l'état latent et attend de nouvelles causes de manifestation qui ne semblent pas devoir être prochaines.

Aux Philippines, l'amiral Dewey est maintenant réduit à l'impuissance faute de renforts qu'on doit toujours lui envoyer et qui ne partent jamais. Pendant ce temps, l'Espagne prépare une expédition qui, devant celle des Etats-Unis, pourrait avoir pour résultat de dépouiller Dewey des fruits de la victoire. L'Espagne cherche en outre à regagner par des concessions administratives la sympathie des natifs insurgés qui n'ont pas la tenacité des Cubains. La question des Philippines est donc loin d'être réglée.

Aux Antilles, on croyait que l'amiral Sampson surveillait la flotte espagnole à l'extrémité est de l'île de Cuba, lorsque soudain l'entrée de Cervera à Santiago, avec sa flotte, a révélé que la flotte de Sampson était dans le voisinage de Key West où elle vient de recevoir l'ordre de se rendre où on la croyait déjà.

Le but du gouvernement semble être maintenant de cerner l'ennemi dans ce port qu'il considère comme une trappe; mais la mission de Cervera est accomplie; il a apperté à Blanco des armes, des munitions et de l'argent, et une dépêche a déjà annoncé qu'il était reparti, ce qui est très vraisemblable; or, comme sa flotte est sensiblement plus rapide que celles de Sampson ou de Schley, il lui sera facile d'éviter de livrer bataille si bon lui semble. Il est donc probable que le calme va continuer à régner autour de Cuba, d'autant plus que l'administration semble prête à céder aux conseils du général Miles, qui trouve les recrues insuffisamment exercées et la chaleur trop intense pour tenter un débarquement dans l'île.

Rien n'indique pour le moment que l'investissement aura lieu avant l'automne. Il n'y avait donc pas lieu de tant se presser, d'autant plus que les recrues n'ont encore ni vêtements ni chaussures. Il est mieux valu, avant de déclarer la guerre, passer encore quelques mois à s'y préparer, et inaugurer les hostilités avec l'activité, la fermeté et l'assurance qui conviennent à une grande nation fière et puissante comme les Etats-Unis.

Au lieu de cela, on a fait preuve d'un emportement puéril et déraisonné qu'il faut modifier ou on devrait au contraire précipiter les événements.—Le Réveil.

On a calculé que la guerre avait coûté, jusqu'ici, aux Etats-Unis, \$3,000,000 par jour et que les reconcentrados mouraient à raison de 500 par vingt-quatre heures, ce qui, depuis la déclaration de guerre, ferait une vingtaine de mille. Il est temps pour les Etats-Unis et pour les reconcentrados qu'on cesse de faire la guerre sur le papier.

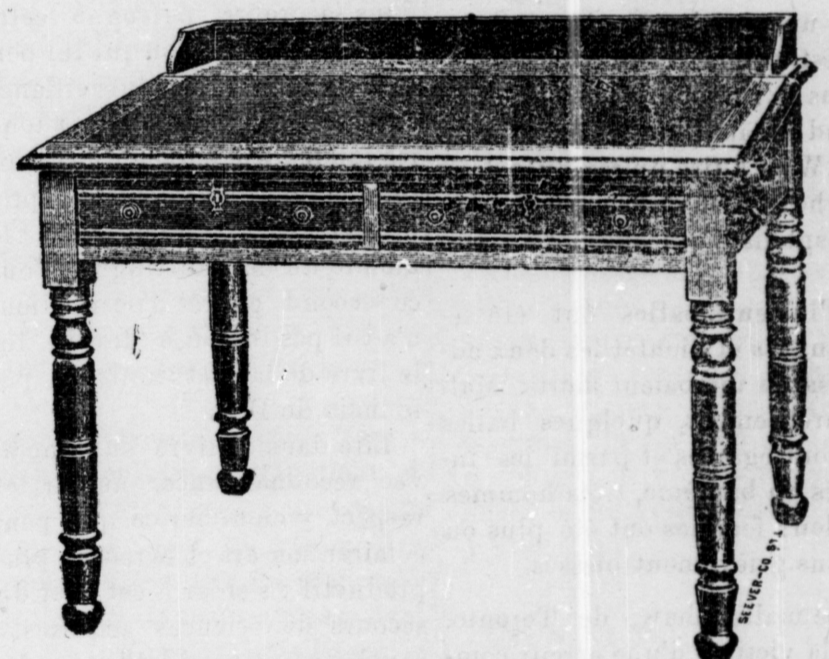
