Toronto Stocks

TORONTO, (CP) — Lower prices for "penny" mining stocks and a shift of interest to western oils Thursday reduced the volume of trading to 5,965,000 shares. Volume was more than 6,000,000 shares lower than last Friday's record.

Uranium issues weakened during the session but a few leaders recovered at the close. New Brunswick base metal prospects also traded lower.

The market generally was firm with western oils adding almost 1-2 points on the exchange index. Base metals weakened but goods showed a small gain.

Among the Saskatchewan uranium-miner was weak during the session but closed three-eighths higher, in a turnover of more than 100,000 shares. Chimo added 14 cents in similar trading. New Delhi, Pitch-Ore and Goldfields dropped pennies.

New Brunswick issues faded slightly although Brunswick added a fraction. New Larder U dropped 28 cents in a turnover of 164,000 shares. Inspiration, with interest in rare metal prospects near North Bay, Ont., traded 124,000 shares to lose 55 cents.

NEW YORK, (AP) — It was rough going for the stock market Thursday after an early rally ran into selling troubles, but at the close the list managed to show slight headway.

Individual issues made a strong showing because of good earnings reports. The tobacco were up as one company after another raised prices, and low priced shares were in demand.

Trading totalled 2,260,000 shares. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks managed to gain 10 cents at \$113.90 with the industrial average unchanged, railroads up 10 cents, and utilities up 10 cents.

Gainers included Santa Fe, Standard Oil N. J., Pan American World Airways, American Cyanamid, Philip Morris, American Tobacco, Lorillard, Liggett and Myers, American Woolen, U. S. Steel, General Motors, Goodrich, and Climax Molybdenum.

Lower prices included Admiral Corp., United Aircraft, Chrysler, Bethlehem Steel, American Telephone, Anaconda, Copper, Phelps Dodge, Baltimore and Ohio, and Loews.

Canadian issues were mixed. Dome Mines and Hiram Walker both added 1/4 and Distillers Seagrams advanced. Canadian Pacific slipped 1/4. International Nickel slipped 1/4 and McIntyre dropped 1/4.
