**Island Odds And Ends**

Construction labor as well as farm labor may be in short supply throughout the Province quite early in the summer. Two big construction jobs are getting underway in Labrador and an American company is already selecting men both in Charlottetown and Summerside, for one of these. Another contracting company is preparing to send recruiting agents to the Island very shortly and the combined efforts of the two companies may draft several hundred men from the Province.

Tradesmen chiefly are being sought at present but scores of laborers will be engaged later. It seems probable that the loss of tradesmen and reliable laborers will have its effect on local wages. It is understood that some Charlottetown contractors are already feeling the need of experienced carpenters, and one or two garages have lost mechanics to the Labrador job.

Farm help, a developing problem all spring, is being further hit by the outside calls for labor, and farmers are offering considerably more money both to single and married men than they did a year ago. Not a few farmers, despairing of help, are cutting down on cropping, and some very discouraged ones are talking of selling their farms. The farm labor problem is one of the most difficult propositions with which Canada has to cope at the present time. It is national of course, and by no means confined to this part of the Dominion.

Several car-loads of steel piles have arrived in Souris, part of the material to be used on the extensive wharf and harbor improvements which are to be made at that town. The Canada Dock and Dredging Co. has the contract but has not yet commenced operations. A Federal Government dredge is deepening the inner harbor as part of the overall project.

The Island's only dragger, Souris No. 2, has been trying its luck off the Magdalene Banks. Later the fishing vessel will operate nearer home, between the eastern part of the Island and Cape Breton. Last year the new dragger caught haddock in a location never before fished successfully. In fact it had long been accepted that no haddock frequented this particular spot. Souris No. 2 is skippered this year by Capt. Buddy McCormack, a Souris man. She was in charge of a Nova Scotian last summer.

Far away fields look green. Trout fishermen have been scurrying to distant points such as North Lake, East Baltic, Whillock's Pond and Murray River, with fair success. A few cagey individuals, however, have tossed a line nearer home, at Fullerton's Marsh for instance, and landed some beautiful sea trout. The Marsh has given up a number of two-pounders in the last week.
