Chinese Warn Indians To Stay Clear Of Tibet

NEW DELHI (Reuters)—Communist China has warned Indians not to go to Tibet this year because the Chinese are launching a "punitive expedition" against Tibetan rebels. Prime Minister Nehru told the Indian lower house that the Indian consul general in the Tibetan capital of Lhasa was informed that Indian pilgrims would enter Tibet at their own risk.
