Vaccination against Smallpox is compulsory for school children.

**TWO POINTS OF REFERENCE**

East's figuring, in the defense in today's deal, overlooked two vital points.

East dealer. Neither side vulnerable.

It is true that North-South reached three trump without a spade stopper in either hand, but they could not be greatly criticized for this—their bids were persuasive. West opened the heart ten. South won and immediately led a low diamond to the queen. East took his ace—then engaged in deep thought over his next move.

As he explained later, East felt that the only defense would be to find West with a club stopper and a third heart, so that he could put East back on lead. It seemed incredible that West could have the spade ace! So, acting on this analysis, East returned the heart queen to clear his suit. After that, of course, it was all over!
