## Text Of Recent Address By Mr. F. A. Large, Q. C.

As a Liberal Candidate seeking election as a Supporter of the policies and the Government of Honorable Alex Matheson, I will first speak of my personal belief in the qualities of Leadership shown by the Premier and his government over the past two years.
