Hospital Campaign Short Of Last Year's Objective

SUMMERSIDE — With \$15,300 contributed to the Prince County Hospital Century Club, and \$5,721.45 donated to the general membership canvass as of yesterday, both campaigns are below the objective reached last year.

The \$3,560.60 contributed by Summerside citizens to the general membership canvass is only about half of the amount received by the hospital from this source in the campaign conducted last year.

However, some of the rural districts did much better than last year. Contributions from these sources amount to \$2,140.85, and there are some districts which have yet to make their remittances, and which will increase the rural total by that amount.
