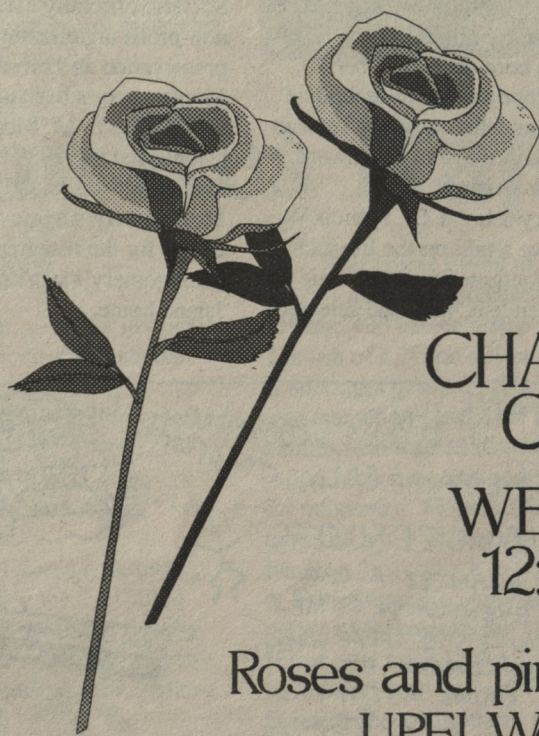
This Week: *Subterranean* is back!
