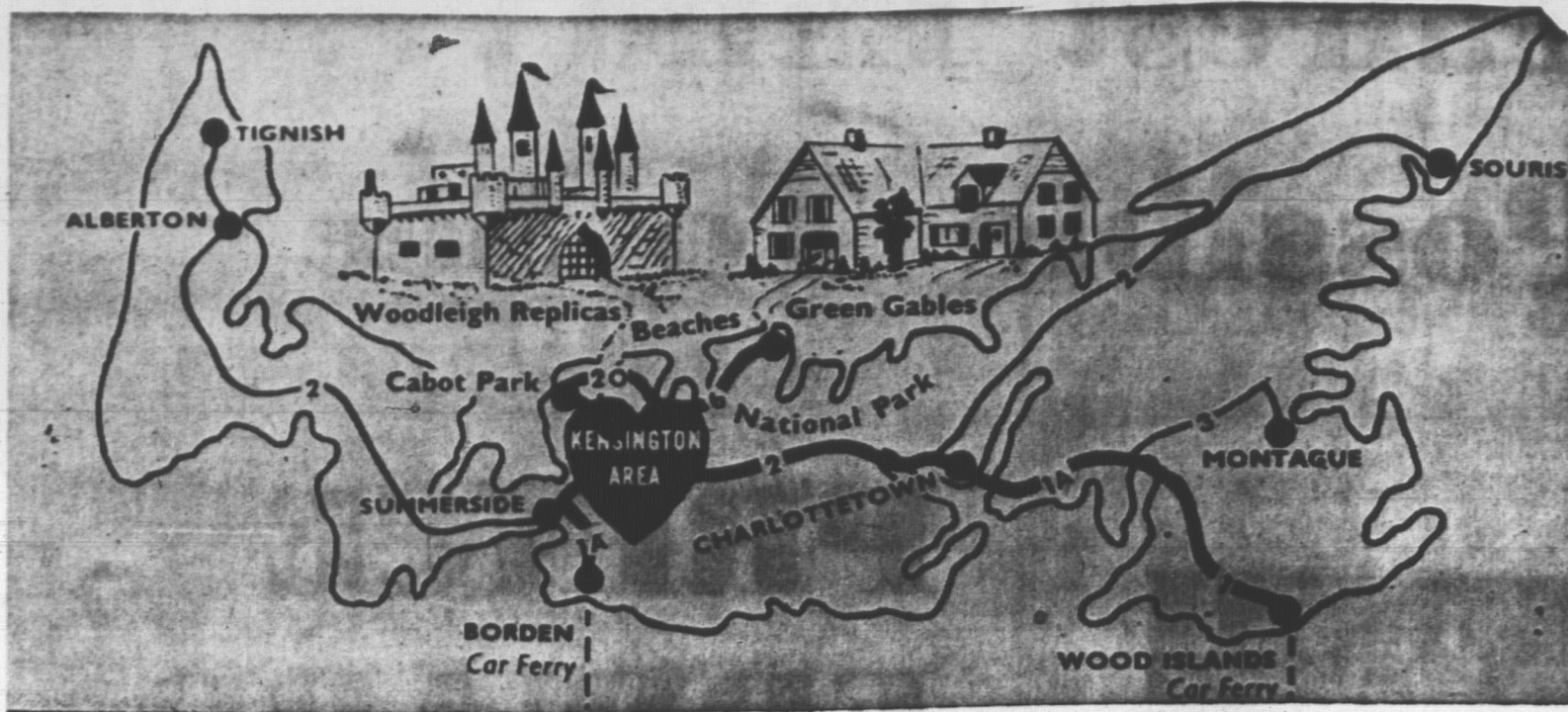

Picture termed obscene

TORONTO (CP) — Dorothy Cameron was charged Wednesday with exposing obscene matter to the public view as police seized seven pictures from the Dorothy Cameron Art Gallery. The pictures were from the show Eros '65 which opened at the gallery last week. Last Friday police ordered Miss Cameron to take one picture down and took photographs of 15 others.

One picture seized Wednesday was "Lovers No. 1, the painting police ordered Miss Cameron to take down Friday. The picture, by Hamilton artist Robert Markle, is a brush drawing showing three reclining female nudes as three figures in black space. Mr. Markle said the painting represents sexual love between women.

Miss Cameron, who will appear in Magistrate's court June 27, said Tuesday that David Coon, chairman of the attorney-general's committee on obscene literature, had said last week the picture is not obscene.
