SEALED TENDERS, for the supply of Clothing for the Militia and Permanent Corps, comprising Tunics, Trowsers, Great Coats, Helmets, Caps; Militia Store Supplies and Necessaries, including Boots, Fur Caps, Mitts, Sheets, Saddlery, Horse Blankets, Gun Powder, etc.; Hard and Soft Coal; Hard and Soft Wood (English measure) for the heating of all military buildings in each of the Military Districts, will be received up to noon on THURSDAY, 14th of June, 1893. Tenders to be marked on the left hand corner of the envelope: "Tender for Militia Clothing," "Militia Store Supplies," "Gun Powder," "Coal," or "Fuel Wood," as the case may be, and addressed to the Honorable the Minister of Militia and Defence, Ottawa.

Every article of Clothing, Store Supplies and Necessaries, as well as the material therein, must be of Canadian manufacture, and similar in all respects to the samples and patterns which can be seen at the Militia Stores at Ottawa. This does not apply to Helms, Forage Caps, nor to material for saddlery.

No tender will be received unless made on a printed form furnished by the Department, nor will a tender be considered if the printed form is altered in any manner whatever.

City By-Law.

A By-Law for levying and specifying the rate of Assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown, for general civic purposes, under Statute 51 Victoria, Chapter 12.

1st. The rate of assessment on Real Estate for general civic purposes, under said Statute, for the year commencing the first day of January, A. D. 1893, and ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1893, is hereby fixed and fixed at the rate of ONE PER CENT. on every dollar of the value of Real Estate, as assessed by the Assessors of the said City of Charlottetown in the General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll of all Real Estate and Personal Property liable to taxation in said City, and to persons liable to pay Poll Tax therein, made and duly returned by them on the seventh day of April, A. D. 1893.

A By-Law for allowing a rate of Discount on the Assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown, for general civic purposes, for the current year ending the thirty-first day of December, A. D. 1893.

1st. A discount at the rate of two and a half per cent shall be allowed to all taxpayers who shall on or before the fifteenth day of July next, A. D. 1893, pay to the City Clerk, at his office, the taxes severally due by them for the current year on Real Estate and Personal Property for Civic purposes.

P. E. ISLAND. PARTIES using the Telephone would find talking much more satisfactory if they would observe the following rules:- 1st. Speak with the mouth about four inches from the transmitter. 2nd. Speak in a moderate tone of voice, not too loud and distinctly. 3rd. Place the telephone so as to cover the ear just as if you wished to shut out all other sounds (do not press too hard on the ear). It is possible to talk and be heard when standing back two or three feet from the transmitter. If you shout too loudly, however, it is a pleasant mode of conversation, is entirely unnecessary, and is a useless waste of wind and lungs, besides being very annoying to all within range of your voice.
