WINNIPEG, March 6 - (CP) - Prices of coarse grains futures showed a firm undertone and moved a narrowly today during a dull session of the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. The firmness reflected upturns in U.S. markets. Commercial demand was limited. There were a few shipping orders in oats and barley in connection with domestic sales. Flax trade was limited to a few domestic processing orders. There was limited U.S. demand for rye. Export loadings of wheat reported overnight included: United Kingdom 500,000 bushels, India 350,000, South Africa 365,000, and Belgium 75,000. Milling grades of Class II wheat were down two cents but durums were unchanged. Prices of I.W.A. wheat also were unchanged. Closing prices: Oats - May 91 1/4; July 83; Oct. 80B. Barley - May 1.27 1/4; July 1.21; Oct. 1.16 1/2. Rye - May 1.93 1/2; July 1.90 1/2; Oct. 1.80B. Flax - May 4.34 1/2; July 4.26 1/2; Oct. 4.15N.
