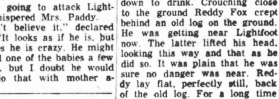

**CONTRACT BRIDGE**

**QUIZ**  
1. Pass. The jump bid of two notrump by the opening bidder shows a balanced hand containing 17 to 19 high card points. If partner then bids either four with strength or stoppers in the unbid suits, it is a highly descriptive bid and the level the responder can frequently tell at the partnership can reach.  
2. The two notrump bid is by no means forcing. It means only what it says — a great interest in game. If the responder has unbid suits, there can be only a remote chance to make nice tricks. It is likely to prove a struggle.  
3. Three spades. An ultimate slam contract seems pretty well indicated. With 13 high card points, plus the distributional values, as well as first or second round controls in all suits, twelve tricks are very likely.  
4. Three clubs. Again there is a chance for a slam, but this time we can't bid it ourselves on the evidence to date. All that can be done is to urge partner to bid a slam.  
5. Bidding three clubs, intending over the expected three notrump, by partner to jump to five diamonds, a slam contract will be strongly suggested. The North will infer that we have a three-trick advantage over the other three suits, and will carry on if that is the key to the slam.

**Oil Under Territorial Waters Is Subject Of Bill**

**OTTAWA (CP)** — The federal government wants to grant mineral and oil rights on submerged lands within its jurisdiction, but the extent of territorial waters is controversial. It is a subject of international negotiation.  
Legislation to give the government power to grant applications was introduced in the Senate Tuesday by government leader John T. Head and received first reading.  
However, the proposal bill does not specify the lands involved.  
"I am tempted to slap the water with my tail as a warning sign," said Paddy.

The bill states that territorial lands mean lands in the Northwest Territories or the Yukon Territory and any other lands which are not located in any of the 10 provinces.  
The legislation does not refer specifically to coastal territorial waters, nor under international investigation. An international subject is scheduled for early next year at Geneva.  
An official of the northern affairs department said the legislation is designed for only one purpose — to give the federal government power to administer lands under James Bay, Hudson Bay and Ungava Bay.  
Various companies are interested in exploiting mineral and oil resources located on lands under these three bodies of water.  
The federal government always has had jurisdiction over these submerged lands. However, no legislation exists under which the government may grant title to mineral and oil claims on such lands.
