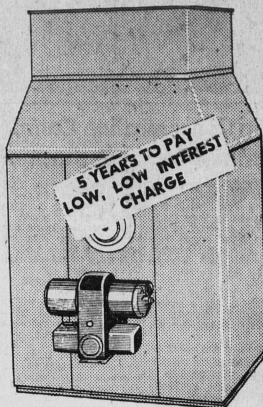
Number of Farms Show Drop in Canada

OTTAWA (CP) — A total of 480,800 farms, 333,293 of them commercial operations, were recorded in the 1961 farm census, the Dominion Bureau of Statistics reported.

The figures compare with 622,691 farms in 1951 when 385,280 of them were classified as commercial. But in that period the bureau changed its definition of farms, and if the 1951 method had been used last year an additional 40,731 farms would have been listed.

The definition of commercial farms—those selling \$1,200 or more in a 12-month period—remained the same.

In the 1961 census, a farm was defined as a holding of three acres or more or a holding of between one and three acres that produced sales of \$250 in the previous year. The 1961 definition called for one or more
