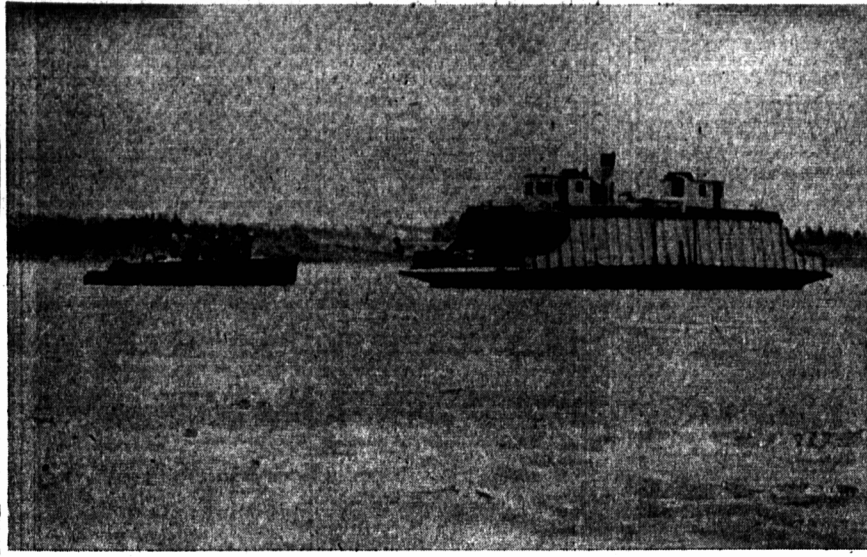

**Rocky Point Ferry In Difficulty**



The Rocky Point ferry "Fairview" was becalmed in midstream at 12:40 yesterday afternoon when she was making the return trip from Rocky Point. A broken over-speed governor was the cause of the engine stoppage. It is expected that a delay of a few days will be experienced before the defective part can be replaced since it will have to come from either Saint John or the United States. In the meantime the Montague II which has been tied up since it relieved the Fairview last spring will go into service this forenoon. When the breakdown occurred the ferry dropped anchor and called for help by whistle blasts. A tow boat went to the assistance of the disabled craft and brought it to its berth. A motor boat was brought into service for the remainder of the afternoon.

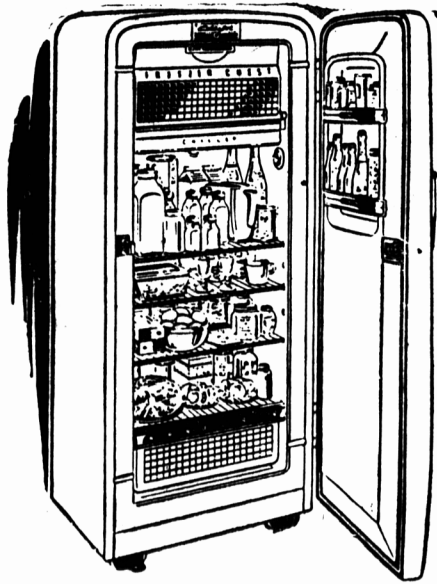
