MONTREAL, July 28 (CP)—Egg and butter prices ruled unchanged on open produce markets here today, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. N. B. and Maine and P. E. I. potatoes were again steady, but Quebec new crop dipped about five cents. Cheese offerings firmed slightly. Creamery butter prints to retail-ers sold for 22 1-2-28 cents a pound and solids for 22-22 1-2. Western butter delivered in Montreal was unquoted. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized in wholesale jobbing lots made 21 5-8. Ontario white and colored cheese were both quoted at 12a. Quebec white was quoted at 11 1-8a and colored at 11 1-4a. Graded egg shipments in used free cases sold at 27-28 cents a dozen for A-large, 25 1-2128 for A-medium, 18-19 for B-large, 15 for C. Potatoes: N. B. and Maine No. 1 mts 75's 1.25-1.30; P. E. I. No. 1 mts 75's 1.25-1.35; Quebec new crop No. 1 75's 75c; Quebec new crop No. 2 75's 60-70. MONTREAL, July 28 (CP)—Butter prices were steady to a shade down while cheese improved a bit in price trading on the Canadian commodity exchange today. A-large and A-medium eggs added from 12 to one cent and B and C grades held unchanged. Butter spot: Que. (92 score) 21 12-5-8; Que. (88 score) 20 3-8b; Sales: 400 Que. (92 score), 21 1-2. Cheese spot: Quebec white 10 3-4; Quebec colored 10 7-8-11 1-4. Eggs spot: A-large 28b; A-medium 26b; B-large 17b; C 15b.

Currencies

NEW YORK, July 28 (CP)—The Canadian dollar held the spotlight in the foreign exchange market here today, moving up to par with the United States dollar for the first time since April last year. Although the closing offering price was 100 United States cents, the bid rate was at a discount of 1-64 per cent representing the normal spread. General improvement of Canadian exports was responsible for the strong position of the Dominion unit, according to banking sources. The Canadian dollar closed yesterday at 94 1/2 discount. Other foreign currencies showed little change. The pound was steady at 4.68 1-8 and the franc at 1-4. The Netherlands guilder showed a slight improvement at 53.17. The Swiss franc and the belga was unchanged.
