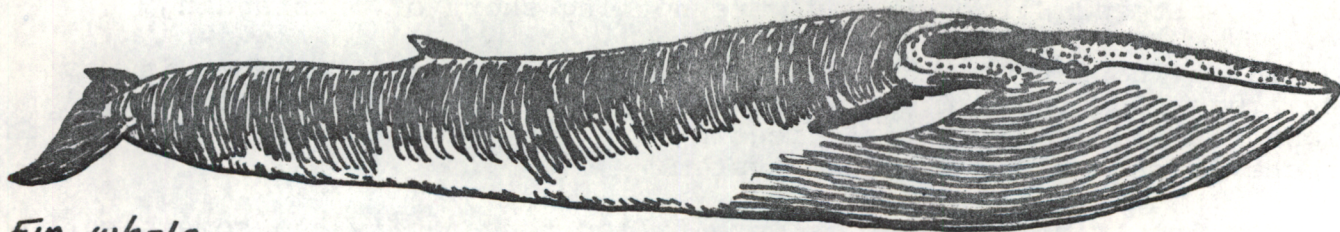


Whatever the real reasons for the recent whale wash-ups, local Department of Fisheries officials, while not unduly concerned, continue to keep an eye on the situation.


On behalf of the Canadian Nature Federation I offer you our heartfelt thanks for all the hard work you put into making the Conference such an outstanding success.
