**Vending Machines Become Big Business In Canada**

TORONTO (CP) — Vending machines are big business in Canada these days, with sales from the push-button dispenser expected to reach about \$100,000,000 this year. Some 600 companies are engaged in the vending machine business and more than 2,000,000 Canadians feed the mechanical dispensers nickels, dimes or quarters each day in return for candy, pop, cigarettes, hot drinks, sandwiches, soups and laundry accessories.

Despite the tremendous growth that has taken place in the industry — it has grown about seven times faster than total retail growth in the last eight years — executives say they are staying away from mechanical restaurants and supermarkets.

Some Canadian companies could install a fully automated supermarket, but the feeling is that Canadians wouldn't respond to it. They prefer personalized service.

Some companies have tried marketing women's hose in dispensers, for example, but the experiments weren't too successful.

Reason: Women prefer to inspect stockings before buying them rather than view them through a window.

As a result, I believe the vending industry's continued growth will stem from sales increases in the standard lines of food, cigarettes and drinks," says A. E. Taylor, general manager of Arco Automatic Retail Co. Ltd.

Another industry spokesman was more optimistic. He predicted that apartment lobbies will one day be equipped with machines selling milk, bread, toothpaste and soft-drinks in cartons.

"As Canadians spend more and more hours on recreation, there will also be a demand for fully automated stores so that retail clerks will be able to get away on weekends," he said.

Report Given On Doctors

OTTAWA (CP)—The number of foreign physicians settling in Canada has increased in four of the last five years, but some doctors are refused permission to practice medicine, the Commons was told here.

Immigration Minister Marchand said in a return for David Orlikov (NDP — Winnipeg North) his department encourages the immigration only of those doctors whose qualifications are approved in advance by provincial licensing authorities.

The department was aware some immigrant doctors were barred from practice but did not know how many. The problem has been discussed with provincial authorities and the Canadian Medical Association.

The immigration department did not automatically bar physicians whose qualifications met with disfavor. But it required them to sign a statement saying they understood they might never be able to practice medicine in Canada.

The return said 445 doctors emigrated to Canada in 1961, 530 in 1962, 667 in 1963, 698 in 1964 and 792 in 1965.

Of those admitted last year, 397 were from Europe, 240 from Asia, 42 from Africa and 118 from other regions.

ADB Spending Plans Revealed

OTTAWA (CP)—The Atlantic Development Board plans to spend \$42,000,000 on capital and research projects in 1966-67, an increase of \$12,000,000 over the fiscal year ending March 31.

Figures in estimates tabled in the Commons show that payments out of the board's \$100,000,000 development fund will be boosted to \$32,000,000 in the next fiscal year.

These payments totalled \$3,642,509 in 1964-65, the first year for such aid, and will climb to an estimated \$25,000,000 in the current fiscal year. This will leave just under \$40,000,000 in the fund as of April 1, 1967.
