ROYALTY OFF FOR THE POLE.

Duke of Abruzzi's Arctic Exploring Expedition Seils

CHRISTIANIA, June 17.—The Stella Polaris with the Duke of Abruzzi, nephew of the King of Italy, and his party on board, sailed "from here yesterday" on her Polar expedition. A large crowd assembled at the wharf to cheer the royal explorer on his departure.

The Duke of Abruzzi's departure from Rome upon his northern expedition produced a sensation. He refused to accept any official farewell, but his outfit attracted a great deal of attention. The baggage that left Rome was arranged in 1,500 portable cases, bearing different colors in order to secure a quicker access on shipboard and ease in storing. Among other things the Duke carried with him from home was an automatic piano to while away the tedious hours of waiting in the Arctic ice floes. Then, too, it was said he shipped to Scandinavia 1,000 bottles of different kinds of liquor, only to be used in cases of emergency. The Duke and his companions ordinarily drink tea, coffee and water.

The royal explorer is a younger brother of the Duke of Aosta and the Count of Turin. He first made himself known in America by an ascension of Mt St Elias last summer. The Duke declares that even if he finds it impossible to reach the North Pole he will go further than his predecessors or never return.

The present expedition consists of twenty persons besides the Duke—Capt. Umberto Cagni and Lieutenant Quici, of the Italian navy; Dr. Caville-Molinelli, two Italian sailors, four mountain guides, ten Norwegian sailors and one Eskimo.

The Stella Polaris is a brigantine fitted with an auxiliary engine. There are 120 dogs on board, a large collection of scientific instruments, cards, chess, draughts, a phonograph, a graphophone, a melodeon, a mechanical piano, pipe, tobacco, cigars, table delicacies, books and cameras.

The winter will be occupied in scientific observations. Next spring, using sleds, and possibly two balloons, the expedition will push towards the North Pole as straight as possible over the ice. It is estimated that the expedition will be gone a year and a half.

BONES FROM HIS SKULL

A Surgical Operation Performed at New York Hospital.

NEW YORK, June 17.—A wonderful operation by which the reason of a three-year old boy was restored was recently performed at Bellevue Hospital by Professor Woodley, of Bellevue University, assisted by Drs. Christian, Wilson and Loomie of the hospital staff.

Mrs. Freedman, of No. 416 West Fifty-third street, took her boy, Leo, to the hospital on April 28, and two days later he was discharged as an idiot.

The boy was suffering from microcephalians, or hardening of the sutures of the skull, which arrested the head's growth.

The Freedman's family physician, Dr. Gruger, went to Professor Woodley and got him interested in the case. The boy was taken to the hospital on May 13 and the operation was performed.

A lengthwise incision of six inches was cut in the dome of the skull, and then on either side triangular pieces of the bone about two and a half inches each in dimension were taken out. The triangular spaces were then filled with sterilized celluloid copper plates.

The skull will now have a chance to expand normally. The patient came out of the operation in splendid condition, and the surgeons were enthusiastic. They say there is little doubt now of the boy's recovery, and that he will grow up sound in mind and body.

Holy Carpet of Mahomet.

LONDON, June 17.—The Cairo correspondent of the Daily Mail says:—"A party of Bedouin Arabs recently attacked a convoy of Egyptians with the Holy Carpet of Mahomet, between Mecca and Medina. A fierce conflict ensued. Four soldiers and three civilians of the convoy were killed and the rest fled. The Bedouins hold the carpet for ransom."

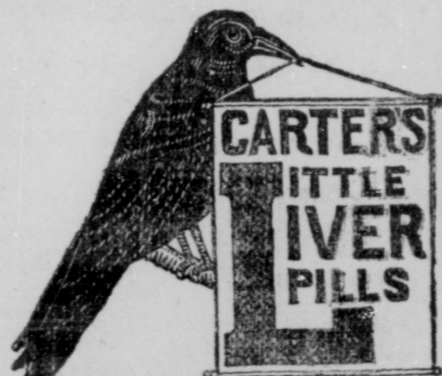
NEWS NOTES.
