 "On behalf of the officers, non-commissioned officers, airmen and airwomen of RCAF Station Summerside, I would like to extend a cordial invitation to the citizens of Prince Edward Island to join with us on Wednesday,

July 1st, when we present an air show in commemoration of the 50th anniversary of flight in Canada, and the 35th anniversary of the RCAF.
 "The year 1909 saw a chain of events which eventually led to Hon. J. A. D. McCurdy's historic flight in the Silver Dart from the ice of frozen Baddeck Bay. Now, 50 years later, one needs only look skyward to see a striking illustration of the growth of aviation.
 "The RCAF, as well, from a very modest beginning in 1924, has experienced a tremendous growth which now places it as

Canada's largest fighting force. At home and abroad the men and machines of the RCAF are continuing their unceasing vigil in the cause of freedom.
 "Our show this year will feature a full size replica of the Silver Dart, the Golden Hawks, and many other interesting displays. We appreciate your interest in the job we are attempting to do and this show will give you an opportunity to see how your RCAF operates in performing its task of providing national security through air power.

Display By Golden Hawks To Highlight 'Open House'

SUMMERSIDE — The RCAF's now famous "Golden Hawks" precision aerobatic team, which is being seen by millions of Canadians this summer during the team's tour of the country, will be featured as part of the air show Wednesday at RCAF Station Summerside marks Air Force Day.
 This team, organized to take part in the activities celebrating the golden anniversary of flight in Canada and the RCAF's 35th anniversary is one of the few air force aerobatic teams to perform on a nation-wide basis since the famed "Siskins" toured the country in connection with the Trans-Canada Air Pageant of 1931. The Hawks perform in gold, Red, and white F86 Sabre Jets.
 Formation aerobatics have long been a part of military flying and teams such as the U.S. Navy's "Blue Angels" and the Royal Air Force's "Black Knights" are world famous. Now to join this select group of precision perfect pilots the Royal Canadian Air Force presents the "Golden Hawks."
 Leading the group of eight skilled pilots selected for the teams is Squadron Leader Fern Villeneuve, 31, of Ottawa. S/L Villeneuve is considered to be one of Canada's top Aerobatic pilots. Three other members of the team combine with him to form a four-plane formation. While two others perform solo displays. There are two spare pilots available to fill in any position as required.
 In their Summerside appearance the "Golden Hawks" will stage a 25 minute sequence of loops, rolls, cross-overs, bomb-
